### AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECTS

<u>AIP – 62 (Terminal HVAC, Roofing Replacement) – Dick Anderson Construction and their subs</u> (Summit Roofing) have started receiving some of the materials for the terminal roof and HVAC replacement project that will physically occur in the spring of 2024. You can see some of the materials have been laid down just East of the terminal apron as they arrive. The lead times for the HVAC materials are the longest lead items, so we anticipate they will continue to arrive along with the roofing materials throughout the winter. The materials are sealed in plastic to be protected from the weather. Jeff recommended approval of the claims as submitted.
